- Help paying for medically necessary equipment for sensory or other mental health needs.

A few examples of qualifying needs are:

- Orthopedic supplies like special shoes for ankle braces
- Help offsetting post adoption costs for inpatient mental health services
- Coverage of adoptive family physicals if the child does not qualify for adoption subsidy
 - Trauma Assessments

Some examples of unmet medical needs:

Physical needs:

- Eye exams, glasses, dental work, yearly physicals, prescription medical equipment

Mental health needs:

- Out of network psychological and psychiatric therapy, trauma assessment

Transportation needs:

- Visiting specialized doctors out of town

We hope to be able to assist with medical needs not covered by the following services:

- Primary insurance
- MI Child
- Children's Special Health Care Services (CSHCS) funds
- Other state funded programs

Adoption Option Inc. was initially founded to provide adoption services, help children in the foster care system and to share free information about adoption and foster care. The agency started expanded services as the need presented.

Some of the expanded services include licensing to become a foster parent and LEAP, a summer program formed to help foster youth focus on the benefits of education. As the agency has grown and developed it started offering family preservation services to help children reunify with their biological parents.

We now provide several types of family preservation programs. Our agency is pleased to assist families with a diverse array of child welfare services.
